



# **Congratulations!**

### Dental Alumni Endowed Faculty Fund 2025

Congratulations to Dr. Grace Huang, who was awarded the Dental Alumni Endowed Faculty Fund for 2025. The funds will be used for a pilot clinical study on the oral health of a population with a disease. Prader-Willi rare Syndrome. We have established collaboration with Seattle Children's Hospital to recruit the subjects. The funds will be used for consumable supplies dental sample for collection, and reagents and service fees for sample analysis, including proteomics analysis and analysis. microbiome They will collect preliminary data from the pilot clinical study and submit a NIH R01 application in October of this year.

#### **Graduate Prosthodontic Residents**

Every year, the American College of Prosthodontists administers a 150-question written exam called the National Prosthodontic Resident Exam. The goal of the exam is to give program directors an idea of how their residents rank compared to other residents around the country and to assist in preparing residents to take the written exam (Section A) of the American Board of Prosthodontics. Residents must successfully pass this exam to continue on to the next three sections for board certification. This year, our graduate prosthodontic program ranked 1st out of the 49 programs around the country. Additionally, **five of our residents ranked in the top ten in the nation!**




### **Welcome!**


